SOME FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the iSquash Access System?

The iSquash Access system controls door entry and lighting within the club and is linked to court bookings.

How does iSquash Access work?

Access is controlled by a Protégé GX system through an internet connection to a centralised database server and is integrated with iSquash. Lights are linked to Online Bookings and will turn on only for bookings. However, clubs can control access and lights restrictions. There is also a manual override switch so they can be turned on if required (for cleaning and events).

Who can use iSquash Access?

All Squash New Zealand affiliated clubs are entitled to setup and use the iSquash Access system.

Only the members of your club who are registered in iSquash are able to access your club via a swipe key (at an additional cost).

Why should our club use iSquash Access?

People access clubs in a number of ways depending on location, staffing and security systems. The iSquash Access system is linked with Online Booking and enables clubs to manage their facility more securely by allowing you to turn the swipe key access on / off online from any location with an internet connection.

What are the benefits of having iSquash Access?

iSquash Access manages who can enter your clubs facilities and controls when the lights come on and off, which saves costs. It can also be linked to heating, air-conditioning and other security systems such as CCTV.

What equipment is needed and is there a cost?

A Protégé GX system controller needs to be purchased and locally installed (by VIP Security) which replaces any existing access systems but re-uses locks, wiring and cables where possible. Once setup the only ongoing costs will be for any system maintenance, monthly internet charges and the purchase of any additional swipe keys.

Who should I contact to setup iSquash Access?
